SEDA recognises the fundamental contribution to developing academic practice that occurs within disciplines. This is being led by those working and supporting academics in Subject Centres and CETLs across the sector. This invitation from SEDA is for representatives of CETLs and Subject Centres to come together, to explore and discuss a new SEDA-PDF award in **'Enhancing Academic Practice in..... X'**

Subject Centres and CETLs may find the proposed award of interest as a means of recognising and rewarding academic practice development within disciplines and in areas of themed activity.

SEDA's Professional Development Framework (SEDA-PDF) offers a series of 15 awards recognising the professional development of staff. The awards can be used to,

- inform the design of professional development programmes,
- provide focus for awards around specific activities,
- recognise and reward individual participants' achievements.

The SEDA PDF framework is structured around core values that closely reflect those of the UK Professional Standards Framework. It also uses a set of core development outcomes based on the principles of any professional development cycle: identify-plan-act-review.

Additionally, each SEDA-PDF award uses a set of specialist outcomes which focus professional development activity around the needs and practice of a particular role and / or function within HE. The event will shape these specialist outcomes.

The workshop will take place on **Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> July 2008** at Woburn House in London from 12.00 - 4.00pm. The cost will be £85.00 and will include lunch. Presenters: Nicky Torrance and Ruth Pilkington

The workshop will provide an opportunity for participants to:

- Find out more about the use of SEDA-PDF as a tool for framing and informing professional and academic development activity across the sector
- Explore and discuss a new award for SEDA-PDF that complements and rewards professional development and learning through engagement with Subject Centre and CETL activity
- Collaborate on the creation of a national award for enhancing academic practice.
